



To measure for your awning, you only need to measure two areas: width and height.

1. To measure for the ideal awning width, measure along the exterior wall of your house. For this measurement, follow the line labeled B.

2. Measuring the height is a little trickier.\* You will need to measure up the wall to where you'd like to have the awning. For the height, follow the line labeled A.\*\*

\*The minimum height requirement is 7 feet 6 inches.

\*\*If you are planning to mount the cover above a door wall or window, you will need to add an additional 10 inches. (Shown in the illustration as C.) Awning enclosures require a minimum clearance of 10 inches if mounting above an exit or entrance.
